

## **LAW AND JUVENILE OFFICER POLICY**

If a law enforcement official requests a visit with a student during school time, he/she shall first contact an administrator. The administrator will inform the officer that before he/she is allowed to talk to the student, the parent or guardian must be contacted and be present, if so desired, at the interview.

The above procedure shall also be used if an officer of the court (juvenile officer) requests a visit with a student. The exception of the above will be in cases of suspected child abuse and/or neglect, in which case the officer of the court will be allowed to visit with the student before parental or guardian contact. If the officer of the court takes the student from school, he/she shall call the parent or guardian before leaving school with the student. In case the officer does not call the parent or guardian, the administration will make contact before the student leaves.

Probation officers may visit students at school.
