

STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

Students are exposed to diverse opinions on an infinite number of topics through the various mass media. Students who have facts and opinions should be allowed to express them in print as well as through oral communications. However, student editors and writers must observe the same legal responsibilities as those imposed under conventional newspapers and communication media. Thus, no student shall distribute any student publication which:

1. is obscene as to minors according to current legal definition;
2. is libelous according to current legal definitions;
3. creates a material or a substantial disruption of the normal school activity or appropriate discipline in the operation of the school (administrative decision).
